Henry Thompson Niehaus, Sr., passed away peacefully at his home in Easton, MD, on Tuesday, February 3, 2015 with his loving wife by his side. He was 68 years old.

He was born on January 3, 1947, in Neptune, NJ, the son of the late Jeannette R. Thompson Niehaus and Ludwig C. Niehaus, Jr. Mr. Niehaus graduated from Centreville High School, Class of 1966. 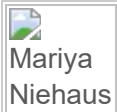

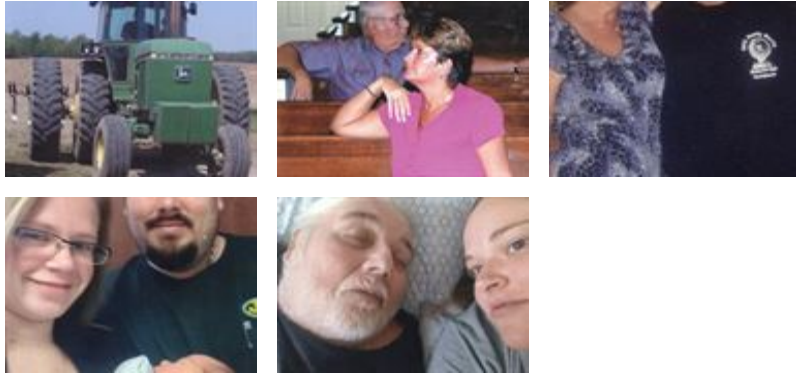

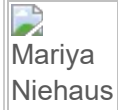
