Henry Calvin McClyment, III of Queenstown, MD died suddenly from complications of a brain aneurysm at University Of Maryland Hospital, Baltimore, MD on Wednesday, June 2, 2004. He was 62.

Born on June 21, 1941 in Chestertown, MD, he was the son of Betty Watson of DE and the late Henry C. McClyment, Jr. He graduated from Bohemia Manor High School in Chesapeake City and later enlisted with the U.S. Navy and served during the Cuban Missile Crisis and Vietnam. Following his release from active duty he began a career with Westinghouse as a plant protection officer. He resided in Baltimore and met his future wife, Carol Ann Bono while working at Westinghouse. They were married on April 6, 1970 and they moved to Queenstown in 1973. He then worked for Western Electric in Baltimore and later returned to Westinghouse/Northrup Grumman as a Lab Technician.

He loved cooking, baking and was known for his "BBQ" sauce, ribs and chili. He also enjoyed flying model airplanes.

In addition to his wife and mother, Mr. McClyment is survived by two sons, Michael Timothy McClyment of Denton and Matthew Henry McClyment of Queenstown; three brothers, Kevin McClyment of Odenton, MD and Brooke Watson McClyment and John Gilmore; three grandsons, Tyler Brannon,

Michael Parker and Joshua Daniel McClyment.
