



Henry W. Lindemann

November 7, 1916 - July 9, 2008

Henry William Lindemann of Ridgely, MD died on Wednesday, July 9, 2008 at his daughter's home in Easton. He was 91.

Born November 7, 1916 in Atwood Kansas, he was the son of the late Dietrich and Marie Kracke Lindemann. At the age of 4 ½ he moved to Cordova, MD with his family. On January 10, 1942 he married Dorothy Plugge. Mrs. Lindemann died March 9, 2003.

Initially drafted into the U.S. Army in May of 1941 and discharged in December of that year, he was again drafted into service in early spring of 1942 after the attack on Pearl Harbor and served until his release from active duty in 1946.

In 1950 he and Dorothy bought a farm in Caroline County where they made their home. Along with farming, he drove a school bus for Caroline County Public Schools.

He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church, Easton where he served as a Trustee and on various committees and offices and sang in the choir for 45 years. He enjoyed music, ball room dancing and was an active member of E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 V.F.W.

Mr. Lindemann is survived by his daughter, Regina Chapman and her husband Ray; and two grandchildren, Eric Chapman and his wife Tara, and Greta Chapman.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, July 15, 2008 at 11:00 AM at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Easton, MD where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
