



## Herbert Ford, Jr.

August 26, 1920 - April 22, 2011

Herbert S. Ford Jr. of Kennedyville, MD died on Friday, April 22, 2001 in the Washington Hospital Center, Washington D.C. He was 90 years old.

Mr. Ford was the son of the late, Herbert S Ford Sr. and Lola Harrison Ford.

He farmed his entire life. He was a member of the Kent County Farm Bureau, and the Shrewsbury Episcopal Church, Kennedyville, MD. Mr. Ford enjoyed gardening, hunting and traveling. For a number of years Mr. Ford was a sales representative for the Gutwein and Garst seed companies. In his earlier years, Mr. Ford enjoyed boating and fishing.
