



## Herbert Clark Gussin

May 17, 1925 - February 20, 2010

Herbert C. Gussin of Easton died on Saturday, February 20, 2010 at Perry Point V.A. Medical Center. He was 84.

Born in Washington, D.C. he was the son of the late, William and Clara Datnov Gussin. After attending Roosevelt High School in Washington, D.C. he fought in WWII as a member of the US Army and US Air Force. After the war Mr. Gussin attended Norwich University in Vermont.

He was a member of the American Legion Post 70 in Easton and the National Rifle Association.

Mr. Gussin is survived by his wife, Helen Gussin whom he married July 9, 1956; one son, William C. Gussin of California and one brother, Norman Gussin of California.

Funeral Services will be held at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton on Wednesday, March 3, 2010 at 11:00 AM, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
