



## Herbert W. Mills

February 17, 1948 - April 6, 2011

Herbert W. "Herb" Mills of Chestertown, MD died on April 6, 2011 at the Chester River Hospital Center.

He was born on February 17, 1948 in Salisbury, Maryland. Mr. Mills was the son of the late Mr. & Mrs. Herbert C. Mills, Jr. He graduated from Chestertown High School in 1966. In 1967, he enlisted in the United States Air Force and served in the Vietnam War.

Upon his return from Vietnam, he graduated from the University of Maryland with a Bachelor of Science Degree and Washington College with a Masters Degree.

Herb dedicated his career to the Kent County Board of Education in many capacities. He was a member of Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post #36. He was a baseball enthusiast; as a player, coach, and avid memorabilia collector.

He is survived by his wife, Donna Robinson Mills of Chestertown, MD, a son, Brandon Mills, his wife Elizabeth, and grandson, Grant of Hebron, KY, and a sister; Donna L. Hollett and husband Jeff of Galena, MD.
