Herman Junior Heinefield of Rock Hall, MD died on Friday, September 11, 2009 on his boat. He was 76.

Born on September 11, 1933 in Skinners Neck, MD he was the son of the late, Herman Heinefield, Sr. and Catherine Reihl Heinefield. He attended school in Rock Hall, MD. Mr. Heinefield served in the US Army in Germany and was honorably discharged in 1960. He married Ruth Ann Gsell on May 7, 1955, she predeceased him on October 3, 2000. Mr. Heinefield began his lifelong career as a waterman purchasing his boat and starting crabbing at the age of 13. He also worked as a carpenter. Mr. Heinefield enjoyed hunting and spending time on the water.

In addition to his wife and parents, he was predeceased by a brother, Ernest Heinefield.

Mr. Heinefield is survived by a son, Joseph F. Heinefield and his wife, Faith of Rock Hall, MD; a daughter, Mary Ann Heinefield Parker and her husband, Jim of Trenton, OH; a brother, Jerry Heinefield of Rock Hall, MD; a sister, Mildred Heinefield Rafine of Rock Hall, MD; also survived by six grandchildren, Holly, Levi, and Bethany Heinefield of Rock Hall, MD and Matt, Mark and Andrew Parker of Trenton, OH.
