



Herman E. Lipsius

Herman E. Lipsius died in Dover, DE on Monday, November 25, 2002.

Born November 15, 1960, he was the son of the late Letha and Herman F. Lipsius of Cambridge, MD.

He graduated from South Dorchester High School in Cambridge, MD and he obtained a Bachelor of Arts degree from Dakota Wesleyan University and a Masters of Divinity from Iliff School of Theology in Denver, Colorado.

Reverend Lipsius was an ordained minister of the United Methodist Church in the Peninsula Delaware Conference. He served as the minister in several local parishes including Kent Island United Methodist Church, St. Marks United Methodist Church in Newark, DE, Sudlersville United Methodist Parish, Cecilton United Methodist Parish and Harrington-Houston Parish in Harrington, DE.

Reverend Lipsius' greatest passions were in support of mission work through his

involvement with the United Methodist Church's Board of Global Ministries. He also worked extensively in building inter-faith and inter-racial worship programs in the communities he served.

Mr. Lipsius is survived by his wife, Sharon Lipsius of Centreville, MD; a sister, Kay Dye of Sebring, FL, and a brother, Winn Lipsius of Cambridge, MD.

The family will receive visitors at the Centreville United Methodist Church on Sunday, December 1, 2002 at 3pm with a funeral service following at 4 pm. A private interment will take place on Monday, December 2 at Woodlawn Cemetery in Easton, MD.
