



## Herman F. Seiter

Herman F. Seiter, a lifelong resident of Easton, died on Tuesday, February 19, 2008 at William Hill Manor, Easton, MD. He was 85.

Born June 4, 1922, he was the son of the late Frederick and Emma Bosse Seiter. After graduating from Easton High School in 1939 he worked for Ward Bakery Company in Baltimore, MD. During World War II, he served in the U. S. Army from 1942 to 1946 and then attended Beacom College in Wilmington, DE, where he completed the Business Administration Course. He then went to work for Preston Trucking Company until 1970 at which time he began a partnership with C.R. Rowens and James Collier at Rowens Stationary. In 1985 he became the sole proprietor of the business until retiring in 1999.

He was a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Easton where he served on the Church Council and various other committees.

Mr. Seiter is survived by his wife, the former Mary Brittingham, whom he married August 19, 1950; three daughters, Gail Seiter of Easton, Linda McKay and her husband Ken of Midlothian, VA, and Barbara Seiter of Portland, OR; three grandchildren, Taylor, Kyle, and Brad McKay; three brothers-in-law, William Kinlock of Easton, Mac Brittingham and his wife Dottie of Easton, and Clyde Koontz of Pittsburgh, PA; and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by two sisters.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, February 26, 2008 at 11:00 AM at Grace Lutheran Church, Easton.

Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
