Hillary Woodrow “Scotty” Scott of Henderson died at Corsica Hills Nursing Home, Centreville, MD, on Tuesday, March 23, 2010. He was 71.

Born March 12, 1939, in Wallville, MD, he was the son of the late, Archie and Gladys Scott. He grew up in Calvert County. Scotty began his career in heavy equipment and driving trucks with Reliable Contracting in Arnold and later with Campbell Sand and Gravel of Crofton, MD, where he worked for 14 years. In 1986, he and his wife moved to Kent Island and established S & S Trucking and in 1992 in Bridgetown. He retired from driving and sold the business after 19 years in 2005.

His hobbies included tinkering in his wood shop and making bird houses with his grandchildren. He loved country music and spending time with his grandchildren.
