H. Marjorie Patterson Leypoldt, formerly of Glen Head, N.Y. and Easton, MD, died April 22, 2007 in Hamden, CT at age 90 1/2. She was the beloved mother of Mark W Leypoldt and Melinda L Lazarus, and dedicated wife of the late Miles K. Leypoldt.

Marjorie was born Oct. 22, 1916 in Dennison, TX, to Alonzo Walter and Hazel M. Patterson. She attended Texas Women's University and studied art, afterwards working as a card designer for Hall Brothers in Kansas City, MO. Besides her life long passion for art, she also was an avid world traveler, bird watcher and animal lover.

Before moving to Easton, the Leypoldts lived in Glen Head, N.Y. where Marjorie was an active artist, member of several community clubs, and held several posts in the North Shore Junior High and High School PTAs. She and her family boated frequently on Long Island Sound.

A resident of Easton since 1972, Marge was a member of the Working Artists Forum and found artistic inspiration in the natural world. She expressed herself in vivid watercolors, Japanese brush painting and excelled at pastel animal portraits. She designed and sewed 8 large banners for the Presbyterian Church in Easton, and was a volunteer for the Memorial Hospital Escort service.

Ms. Leypoldt is survived by her two children; Mark W. Leypoldt Arlington, TX and Melinda Leypoldt Lazarus, of Cheshire, CT.; one granddaughter, Gillian M.L. Lazarus also of Cheshire, CT; numerous nieces and nephews in the Midwest and many friends. Her husband of 62 years predeceased her.

A memorial service will be held on Friday, June 1, 2007 at 1:00 PM at St. Marks United Methodist Church, Easton, MD.
