Hollis T. “Mickey” Cantwell Jr. of Stevensville passed away on March 7, 2022. He was born on Oct 11, 1938, the son of the late Hollis T. and Beatrice R. Eppard Cantwell Sr.

Mr. Cantwell was a graduate of Catonsville High School class of 1958. He proudly served his country by joining the US Army in 1959 and was Honorably Discharged in 1963.
