Holly Mae Crow of Ridgely, MD, passed away on May 18, 2017, at Johns Hopkins Hospital. She was 45.

She was born in Easton, MD on November 17, 1971.

Holly attended Easton High School. On September 9, 1990, she gained a second birthday. Holly was the 100th patient to receive a liver transplant at Johns Hopkins. She started her own business, and became the owner and operator of Cleaning with Pride. On May 24, 2010, she married the love of her life, Robert W. Crow.

She enjoyed the outdoors, whether it was working in her flower gardens or hunting and going fishing. Holly raised Bourbon Red Turkeys, loved sea turtles, and was a huge Tennessee Titans football fan. Friends and family were her world and being a Mom was the most important thing to her.
