



Howard Edmond McIntyre

November 2, 1937 - February 16, 2017

Howard E. McIntyre of Chestertown, MD, died on February 16, 2017, at University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. He was 79. He was born in Baltimore, MD, the son of the late Charles E. and Grace McIntyre nee Loftus.

He was a graduate of Patterson Park High School, the University of Baltimore, BA; Loyola College, MA; and the University of Maryland, EdD. Mr. McIntyre served in the U.S. Army from 1960 to 1962.

He was involved in education throughout his life. He taught mathematics and science in Baltimore County and Kent County, was a principal of Galena School, and retired as the director of Staff development for the Calvert County Public Schools. After he retired, he was a kayak instructor and tour guide and volunteered much time and effort to the care and preservation of Eastern Neck National Wildlife Refuge and Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge. Howard continued to learn and study, writing poetry, taking photographs, and learning to play the ukulele. He was a bagpiper. He was a birder. He ran the Live Poets' Society Poetry Contest, and volunteered for years at the Medical Adult Day Care. Mr. McIntyre served as Past Master of Chester Lodge #115 A.F. & A.M.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Lynne Sterling McIntyre; a daughter,

Deirdre McIntyre; two brothers, William McIntyre and Reverend John McIntyre; a sister, Kathryn "Kev" Smith; his mother-in-law, Elma Sterling; along with his two grandchildren, Mabel McIntyre Quinn and Cora McIntyre Quinn.

A Celebration of his Life will be held on Sunday, April 23, 2017, at 2:00 pm, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Chestertown, MD.

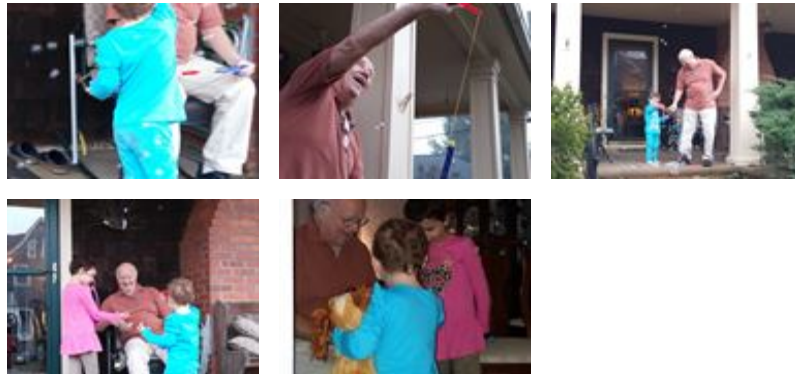

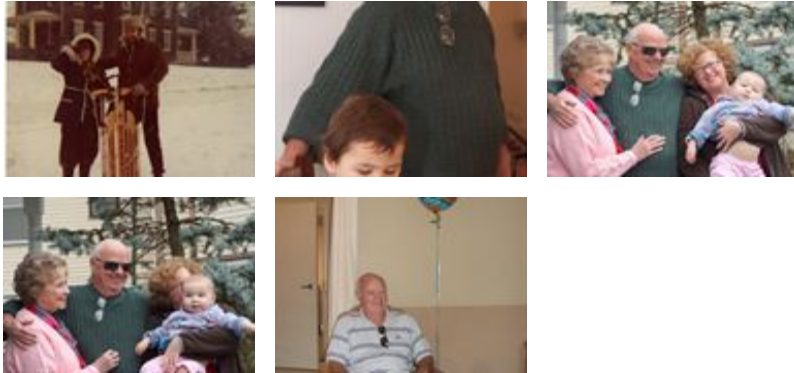
