



## Howard Dallas Morrison

March 13, 1933 - June 27, 2023

Howard Dallas Morrison of Dover, DE, died at Harmony of Kent on June 27, 2023. He was 90.

Born in West Blossburg, PA, he was the son of Hugh L. Morrison and Marion Curtis. He lived in Mansfield, PA, Myersdale, PA, and Salem NJ. He graduated from Salem High School, where he was in the All-State Band. He attended Washington College in Chestertown, MD, as a political science major; he was in the Phi Sigma Kappa fraternity and graduated Sigma Cum Laude. He earned a Master's degree at McDaniel's College in Westminster, MD. Mr. Morrison worked for Baltimore County Board of Education, first as a history teacher at Arbutus Middle School and Lansdowne High School before a long career as a Pupil Personnel Worker in Baltimore County.

He was a member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Ocean City, where he had served as a Stephen's Minister.

Howard served in the U.S. Army as a medic in the helicopter unit.

He was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed camping, hiking, whitewater canoeing and fishing. He traveled extensively in the United States and Europe. However, Howard's pride and joy was in the beautiful A-frame cottage he built along the Mississippi River in Ontario, Canada, where he spent many

summers and holidays with his family and friends.

He is survived by his wife of sixty-six years, Carol A. Morrison; his son, Kyle M. Morrison and partner Patty Biggs; his daughter, Heather and husband Dave Rausch; daughter, Sandra and her husband Lucas Niiler; and son; Paul D. Beckwith; eight grandchildren, Ryan and his wife Laura Morrison, Benjamin Morrison, Kelsey and her husband Woody Mott, and Paige Morrison, Michael and his wife Meagan Rausch, Steven and his wife Amber Rausch, James Niiler and John Niiler; and three great-grandchildren, Yvan, Isaac, and Ian Rausch.
