



## Howard Kenneth Schultz, Sr.

March 26, 1922 - February 13, 2015

Howard K. Schultz, Sr., of Chestertown, MD, died on February 13, 2015, at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. He was 92. He was born in Peoria, IL, on March 26, 1922, the son of the late Herman and Eva Schultz. He married Nellie Wagner in November of 1944. They moved to Chestertown where he worked as a manager with the C & P Telephone Company from 1947 until retiring in 1982. To keep up his active lifestyle, he began working as a handyman at Washington College Dining Hall from 1984 until retiring in 2007 at the age of 85. He was a devoted member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Chestertown where he served in several capacities. He was also a member of the Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post 36 in Chestertown.

In addition to his wife of 70 years, he is survived by his daughter, Lynn Beller and her husband, Cleve, of Hyattsville, MD; and his son, Dr. Howard K. Schultz, Jr, and his wife, Lana, of Crofton, MD; along with grandsons, Jeremy, Matthew, Kevin, Danny;, and two great-grandsons.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, February 18, 2015, at 11:00 a.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church, 101 Greenwood Ave., Chestertown, MD. Interment will be in Greenlawn Cemetery in Cambridge.
