



## Howard James Schuster

July 22, 1943 - September 27, 2018

Howard James Schuster, 75, of Easton, MD, died on Thursday, September 27, 2018, at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Easton. He was born in Englewood, NJ, on July 22, 1943, son of the late August William Schuster, Jr. and Loretta Marie Kearns Schuster.

Mr. Schuster attended Fort Lee Grammar School and Cliffside Park High School in NJ.
