Howard B. "Junie" Strong of Chestertown, MD died at his home on Sunday, June 3, 2001. He was 81.

Mr. Strong was born in Easton, MD the son of the late Howard B. and Marion Woodall Strong.

Mr. Strong began farming in 1948 near Cecilton, MD and in 1950 returned to Chestertown, MD where he continued farming for 45 years. Mr. Strong was always on the cutting edge of farming and enjoyed building and experimenting with farm machinery.

Mr. Strong was a WWII Army Veteran and left the service as a Tech Sgt. Serving in the 1st Armor Div. He took the Queen Mary to England and fought with General George Patton from England through N. Africa, Anzio then Italy and was among the first Americans to liberate Rome.

Mr. Strong was a member of the St. Paul's Kent Episcopal Church where he served on the church vestry, he was also a member of the Chester River Yacht & Country Club and was a volunteer for the Kent & Queen Anne's Hospital Auxiliary and was also a member of a group called the Bored Directors.

Mr. Strong enjoyed reading, boat modeling, duck and goose hunting, boating, Gardening and flowers.

Mr. Strong was preceded in death by his first wife Margaret Brice and his second wife Margaret Thompson.

He is survived by his wife Cathy Perry-Strong, 1 son John Philips of Webster, NY; 2 daughters, Vicki Philips Marchant of Graniteville, SC and Marion Woodall Bauer of Doylestown, PA. A stepdaughter Bayley Perry of Chestertown, MD and 6 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren.

Memorial services will be held on Thursday, June 7, 2001 at 11:30 a.m. in the St. Paul's Kent Episcopal Church, Sandy Bottom Road, Chestertown, MD.
