



Howard L. Coleman, Sr.

March 12, 1923 - December 28, 2010

Howard Lee Coleman, Sr. died at the Memorial Hospital at Easton on December 28, 2010. He was 87 of age.

Born in Preston, MD on March 12, 1923, he was the son of the late, Rockwood F. Coleman and Effie Covey Coleman. In 1943, Mr. Coleman enlisted in the U. S. Army, serving overseas, including the invasion of France on Utah Beach. He was so proud to have served his country on D Day. Mr. Coleman began working at DuPont and Universal Aviation until opening his own business in 1950, Coleman's Tree Service. Mr. Coleman was influential in assisting many former employees in starting their own businesses. In 1998, he retired.

He loved fishing, trapping, attending auctions, and collecting antique cars. He was a life member of the VFW Post #5118 in Easton.

Mr. Coleman is survived by his wife of 50 years, Myrtle Chance Coleman; his children, Karen Gibbons-Neff, Robert Keith Coleman and his wife, Joyce, Howard "JR" Coleman and his companion, Melinda, Donald N. Coleman and his wife, Trudy, Tammy M. Bradley and her husband, Doug, and Tracy C. Bartholomew and her husband, Kirk; twenty-two grandchildren and twenty-six great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a daughter, Carol Ann Messick, and ten siblings.
