



Huey James Erskine Jr.

April 24, 1928 - February 18, 2016

Huey James Erskine, Jr. of Easton, MD, died on February 18, 2016, at Genesis HealthCare – The Pines. He was 87.

Born in Easton, April 24, 1928, he was the son of the late Huey James Erskine, Sr., and Sallie Kirby Erskine. After graduating from Easton High School, he served in the U.S. Navy from 1946 to 1948. Following his release from active duty, he returned to Easton where he worked for many years as a tire salesman for Price's Tire Shop and later Swann's Tire Center. In 1988, he became a supervisor for Easton's Parks and Recreation Department, a position he held until his retirement in 1997.

A lifelong resident of Easton, he was a member of First Baptist Church; a life member of E. E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 VFW, a member of the Easton Volunteer Department, and a former member and Past Grand of Miller Lodge #18, IOOF.

Mr. Erskine is survived by his wife, the former Elizabeth May Fisher, whom he married in November of 1948; three daughters, Pamela D. Erskine, Kimberly S. Erskine and Patricia D. Hamill (Joe), all of Easton; sons, Huey J. Erskine III (Sharon) of Easton, Dennis E. Erskine (Janice) of Hockessin, DE; a sister, Doris F. Whistler of Wilmington, DE; a brother, Richard B. Barrow of Easton; ten grandchildren; and thirteen great-grandchildren. He was predeceased by a son, Jeffrey A. Erskine; his sisters, Joyce Ero, Betty Fairbank, Fay P. Willey, Della Mae Vorwald, Helen Collins; and a brother, Donald Erskine.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, February 22, 2016, at 11 a.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., in Easton, where friends may call on one hour prior to the service, from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m.

Burial will be at New Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton, MD.

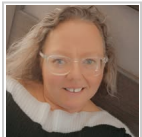
