



Dr. Hugh G. Gregg

October 17, 1932 - March 15, 2014

Dr. Hugh Gilmore Gregg passed away peacefully in his home on March 15, 2014. Gil was born in Corning, NY on October 17, 1932 to the late Hugh and Marjorie Gregg.

Gil graduated Cum Laude from Colgate University in 1954; received his Doctor of Medicine from the State University of New York Upstate Medical University; completed his internship at University Hospital in Syracuse and his residency in radiology at Columbia Presbyterian Medical Center in New York City. He then practiced medicine in New Brunswick, New Jersey until 1970 when he moved to Easton and joined Easton Memorial Hospital's Radiology Department. He was appointed chief of radiology in 1980 and was appointed to the Board of Directors of Memorial Hospital in 1988. He was instrumental in bringing new imaging technology to the radiology department in the 1980s and 1990s. Gil continued to practice medicine at the Hospital and at Shore Radiology until his retirement in 1999.

When not working, Gil's passions were always at home. He was an avid reader and could hold lengthy discourses on many topics with history being his favorite. Gil refused to give into the physical challenges of Spina Bifida which eventually confined him to a wheelchair for the last 33 years of his life. He taught himself to sail and was an avid and active gardener. Each spring brought new joy as he designed and tended the elaborate landscaping in his

yard and planted a sizable vegetable garden. Gil also spent many enjoyable hours in his woodshop designing and completing several fine pieces of furniture.

He is survived by Barbara Hudson Gregg, his wife of 39 years; his brother Dr. Robert Gregg (Barbara) of Bethesda, MD; his two sons: Gordon Gregg (Sue) of New Zealand and Kevin Gregg (Lynda) of Arnold, MD; and four grandchildren; and a niece and nephew.
