



Hugh Paul Knauff

July 15, 1926 - August 24, 2012

Hugh P. Knauff, 86, of Neavitt, MD, died on Friday, August 24, 2012, at the Talbot Hospice House in Easton. He was born in Baltimore on July 15, 1926, son of the late Edgar Knauff, Sr., and Edna Lang Knauff.

He attended Baltimore Polytechnic Institute. In 1943, he enlisted in the United States Navy, serving in the Pacific Theatre of Operations, one day after the bombing of Pearl Harbor. He was honorably discharged in 1946 and returned home to Baltimore. Upon his return home, he began what would become his career with the Carpenters Union #101. On May 7, 1949, he married Marian E. Murawski. They resided in Towson, MD. Mr. Knauff's last employment was superintendent of the construction of the Ikea building in White Marsh, MD. He retired in 1988 and moved with his wife Marian to Neavitt on Maryland's Eastern Shore.

He is survived by his wife of 63 years, Marian, a son; Paul F. Knauff, and two grandchildren, Chris and Amanda Knauff. He was preceded in death by two brothers, Edgar Knauff, Jr., and Gilbert Knauff.

Mr. Knauff was a member of the American Legion Post # 70 in Easton.

A graveside service will be held on Wednesday, September 5, 2012, at 11 a.m. at Parkwood Cemetery, 3310 Taylor Ave., Baltimore, MD 21234.
