



Hugh Lowery

March 4, 1921 - September 30, 2012

The Lord called Hugh Harding Lowery home to His loving arms on September 30, 2012. Mr. Lowery passed away in Easton, MD, at the age of 91.

Born near Dam #4 in Washington County, MD, on March 4, 1921, he was the son of the late Otha Benjamin Lowery and Beulah Lewis, who were share croppers with eleven children.

Mr. Lowery graduated from Hagerstown Business College. He was the lead herdsman for University of Maryland. He joined the US Marine Corps during WWII and served in the Pacific. On his discharge from the Corps, he married his wife, Beatrice Caroline Robinson, on June 23, 1946. He was soon employed as Vice President by Perpetual American Bank in Washington, DC.

He was a Charter Member of the Capital Hill Kiwanis Club and the club's first Vice President. During this time, he became an active member at Grace Baptist Church located at 9th St. and South Carolina Ave. S.E. He served as the church moderator for 14 years. Upon retiring from the bank life, he and Bea moved to Easton, MD, where they worshipped at First Wesleyan Church of Easton.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Lowery is survived by two sons, Jay Lowery, and Chris Lowery; and four grandchildren, Brek, Clint, Megan, and Brooke.

He was preceded in death by four brothers and four sisters.

A chapel service will be held on Friday, October 5, 2012, at 11 a.m. at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veteran's Cemetery near Hurlock.

A memorial service will be held at the First Wesleyan Church of Easton on October 5, 2012, at 2 p.m.

Mr. Lowery donated his brain to Johns Hopkins for Parkinson's Research.
