Bruce Heatly of Easton, MD, passed away on March 28, 2006, at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 73.

Born October 11, 1932, in Cranford, NJ, he was the son of the late Walter Bruce and Barbara Cunningham Heatly. He was a graduate of Colgate University and the American Graduate School of International Management in Phoenix, AZ. As a U.S. Navy Lieutenant j.g., he piloted P2V Neptune patrol planes in the Pacific and the Far East. After his military service, Bruce worked for many years for New York's Citibank and subsequently for the U.S. Agency for International Development in Central and South America, the Caribbean, and Europe.

After retiring to Easton, MD, in 1995, he was active in the United Fund and Historic Easton and other Talbot County organizations where he made his best and most cherished friendships.

Mr. Heatly is survived by his wife, Barbara, of Easton; his daughter, Alexandra, of New York City; his son, Gavin and his wife and two grandsons of Norwalk, CT; and his sister, Jean, of Horseshoe Bay, TX.

A memorial service will be held on Friday, April 7, at 11 a.m. at Shore Harvest Presbyterian Church in Easton. Internment will be private.
