Ian MacKay Patrick of Church Hill, MD died on Tuesday, August 2, 2005 in his home. He was 68.

Born January 1, 1937, in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late, John W. and Dorothy Jackson Patrick. Following graduation from high school, he attended Bucknell University.

He served in the U.S. Coast Guard from 1960 until 1964 in the North Atlantic during the Cuban Missile Crisis and was honorably discharged. He worked as a project manager in the industrial controls division of Honeywell Corp., retiring in 1998. Later he worked with Washington College on the waterfront, assisting students in the boating program. He and his wife resided in Bucks County, PA, before moving to Church Hill, MD in 2000.

He enjoyed downhill skiing, horseback riding, boating on the Chesapeake Bay with his wife for many years, and was also a private aerobatic pilot. He was an active E.M.T. while residing in Bucks County, volunteering with Chalfont Fire and Ambulance Co., where he was recognized for his service.

Mr. Patrick is survived by his wife, whom he married in August 1966, Kathleen Kelly Patrick and a sister and brother-in-law, Margot and Don Nappo of Stanton, N.J.

Graveside services will be 11:30 a.m. Friday, August 5, 2005 in Cedar Bluff Cemetery, Annapolis, MD.
