



## Ida Elizabeth Sadler

October 8, 1918 - January 8, 2014

Ida Elizabeth Sadler went to her Heavenly Father on Wednesday, January 8, 2014, at the age of 95.

She was born Ida Pawloski on October 8, 1918, in the Polish Catholic community of Baltimore, MD. There she attended St. Elizabeth School. In the 1930s, she worked for her aunt at the Kum-On-In opposite Clifton Park where she met Raymond J. Sadler, a linotype operator for the Baltimore Sun. They married on April 13, 1939.

The couple bought and ran the family farm on Bottom Rd. in Hydes, MD, for over 35 years. They enjoyed dancing, fishing, and playing poker. After Ray's retirement they spent two years traveling the U.S. by trailer. In 1975, they moved to Governor Grason Manor on the Wye River to pursue their hobby of fishing and crabbing.

Following her husband's death in 1989, she moved to a Chester, MD, community where she was well known as "Miss Ida." Despite severe macular degeneration she maintained a beautiful home and was avidly interested in politics and the Bible. She loved people—from her neighbors, to her doctors, to tellers, to salespeople.

She is survived by her three daughters, Sandra Balcer of Joppa, MD, and

twins, Linda Sadler and Janet Schap of Baltimore, MD; four grandchildren, Anthony Balcerowicz, II, Lori Wagner, Joseph and Paul Schap; eight great-grandchildren; and three great-great-grandchildren.

Visitation begins at 10 a.m. at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 106 Shamrock Rd. in Chester, MD, on February 8. Mass will be held at 12 p.m. with light refreshments to follow.
