



Ida Mae Wilkins

January 29, 1915 - November 12, 2009

Ida Mae Wilkins of Easton, died at Chester River Hospital on November 12, 2009. She was 94.

Born in Talbot County on January 29, 1915, she was the daughter of the late, Capt. George E. and Mary Alice Smith Jackson. After attending public school, she, on April 8, 1939, married Merritt O. Wilkins. They made their home in Easton. She worked for eighteen years from 1959 until 1977 as a nurse's aide at the Rio Vista Nursing Home in St. Michaels and then did private duty patient sitting for a number of years.

Mrs. Wilkins was a lifelong resident of Talbot County, except for the last four years, which she spent living with her son, Benny, in Chestertown.

She was a member of Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton. Her hobbies included working in her yard and going boating.

Mr. Wilkins died July 12, 1978.

Survivors include a son, Benny M. Wilkins of Chestertown; a step-son, Gene M. Wilkins of Delaware; three grandchildren, Bryan Wilkins, Eric Wilkins and Stacie Wilkins, and four great grandchildren. Her brothers, George E. Jackson, Jr. and James V. Jackson, Sr. predeceased her.
