Ida Marie Harper of Easton, MD, formerly of Royal Oak, died on Saturday, November 1, 2003 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton. She was 93.

Born June 6, 1910 in Fobes, Washington, she was the daughter of Norwegian immigrant parents, the late Erland and Lizbet Scron Dahl Wold. A 1926 graduate of Everett High School, Everett, WA, she then attended Western Washington Teachers College. After graduating in 1929, she did additional studies at the University of Washington. She taught school in Washington State until retiring and moving to Maryland in 1966.

She was a member of Royal Oak Community United Methodist Church, an avid bridge player and enjoyed extensive travels with her husband.

Mrs. Harper is survived by her husband, Donald N. Harper, whom she married in 1947; her daughter, Marylin "Lynne" Ginther of Seattle, WA; a daughter-in-law, Kathleen Smith of Port Republic, NJ; and two grandchildren, Michael Smith and Katie Marie Smith. Her son, Donald Harper Smith died in 1989. She was also predeceased by two brothers, Edgar Wold and Lawrence Wold.
