Ilse Schlesner of Stevensville, passed away on Wednesday, October 13, 2021. She was 77 years old.

Ilse was born on March 17th, 1944, to the late Karl Anton Reiser and the late Emilie Josefine Reiser in Germany.

She came to the United States by herself when she was 16 years old, celebrating her sixteenth birthday on the ship. She then lived with her sisters, until she met her late husband, Rudolf Schlesner. They married in 1963.

Her hobbies included crafts, knitting/crocheting, traveling, going to the casinos, and baking her famous cheesecakes. She loved her dogs.
