Ira Ambrose Shortall, of Easton, MD, died on Wednesday, July 2, 2014, at William Hill Gardens. He was 88.

Born on January 13, 1926, in Easton, MD, he was the son of the late William Shortall and Maude Andrews Shortall.

Mr. Shortall graduated from Easton High School. He farmed in Miles River Neck and Cordova. After he retired from farming, he worked for ABC and Elliott Farm Equipment and was a courier for Shore Health Laboratories.
