proud you were of Carl and how he took great care of you. You had*

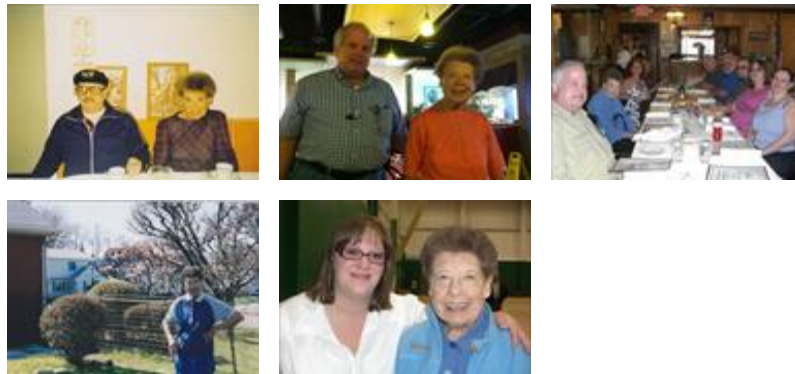
such a loving relationship and two days before you were blowing kisses his way. What a picture memory I have that will be with me forever. It was so obvious how much you loved each other in how you treated one another.
