November 17, 1934 - January 29, 2015

Irene N. Sedgwick of Easton, MD, passed away on Thursday, January 29, 2015, at her residence. She was 80.

Irene attended Bridgeville High School. She then married the late William J. Sedgwick, Jr., in 1951 and moved to Caroline County. The year following, the couple moved to Talbot County, where Irene got a job working with Eskay in Cordova until 1963. She then moved on to work in the office at Mansfield and Sedgwick until 1979 when the business was sold and became Mansfield and Son. Following this, she took a position at William Hill Manor where she worked until her retirement.

Irene is survived by three children, Rena Sedgwick States of Preston, William J. Sedgwick, III, (Darla) of Cordova, and Charles O.
