



Irene Wolf Cunningham

June 22, 1930 - April 22, 2008

Irene Wolf Cunningham of Stevensville, MD, died on Tuesday, April 22, 2008, at Future Care Chesapeake Nursing Home surrounded by her loving family. She was 77 years old.

She was born on June 22, 1930, to the late Herbert Wolf and Helen Labuda Wolf and grew up in Baltimore where she graduated from The Catholic High School of Baltimore in 1948. She graduated from St. Joseph's Nursing School in 1951 and began working in nursing in the Baltimore area. While working for the Army Hospital at Ft. Holabird, she met the base Provost Marshal Lt. Col. Donald H. Cunningham whom she married in 1963. The couple moved to Stuttgart, Germany, in 1964 when her husband was stationed there. During the next several years, they also lived in Brooklyn, New York, while Col. Cunningham worked in the area.

When her husband retired in 1971, the couple moved to Stevensville, where, their son, Curtis Wolf Cunningham, was born that year. In 1976, Irene entered the real estate business, working with Reginald Jones on Kent Island. An active sales associate, she served as president of the Queen Anne's County Association of Realtors and retired in the early 1980's. In addition to her real estate business, Irene devoted her time to raising her son and caring for her home on Davidson Drive. After Col. Cunningham passed away in September, 1994, Irene traveled occasionally to Europe but was content to enjoy her

home and family.

Mrs. Cunningham is survived by a son, Curtis Cunningham, and his wife Claudia of Queenstown, MD; a stepson, Donald H. Cunningham, Jr., and his wife Angelyn of Falls Church, VA; and one grandson, Evan Cunningham, a fourth year student at the University of Virginia. Her sister, Elaine Wolf Paalz died in 1981.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. on Friday, May 2 at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., 106 Shamrock Road, Chester, MD 21619, where family and friends may call one hour before. She will be buried at Arlington National Cemetery on Wednesday May 21, 2008, at 10 a.m. The family requests that, in lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be made to the Kent Island Volunteer Fire Department, P.O. 26, Stevensville, MD 21666.
