



Irma Miller

March 3, 1938 - December 17, 2011

Irma McMahan Miller died at the Talbot Hospice House on the early morning of Saturday, December 17, 2011, after a relatively brief time with cancer. She was 73.

Born in Easton, MD, on March 3, 1938, she was the daughter of Dewey Henry McMahan and Irma Jones McMahan. She attended schools in Easton and attended Washington College in Chestertown, where she met her husband of fifty three years, William C. Miller. They were married in Easton at Christ Episcopal Church on September 20, 1959. She was an owner and officer of McMahan Oil Company in Easton for most of her working career. McMahan Oil Company was founded by her father in the 1940's.

She raised her three sons in a variety of locations including Waynesboro, VA, and Roanoke, VA, but the majority of her life was spent in Easton, MD, raising and caring for her family.

She was proud that she was able to quit smoking in 1973, and this led to her interest in exercise, health, and fitness. She took many aerobics classes in the early seventies and eventually taught and developed several adult exercise programs through the Talbot County YMCA and elsewhere. She could often be seen walking her beloved Labrador Retrievers or exercising at the "Y." Some of her favorite pleasures were cruising on the family boat under the light

of a full moon or sitting on a beach in the late afternoon after a day of reading. She took care of her family until her last days. She was a wise and caring person who never lost her thirst for knowledge.

In addition to her husband, she is survived by two sons, Michael Miller, (Julia) and Timothy Miller (Amy); five grandchildren, Erin, Brian, Jack, Caroline, and Timmy Jr.; and three sisters, Anne McMahan, Myrtis Messenger, and Page McMahan Joy. She was preceded in death by her parents, Dewey Henry McMahan and Irma Jones McMahan; her sister, Sue Ricketson; and a son, Brian Keith Miller.
