



Irving F. Morris

July 4, 1921 - July 12, 2010

Irving Frederick Morris passed away on July 12, 2010 at Genesis Healthcare - The Pines in Easton, MD. He was 89 years old.

Born in Greensboro on July 4, 1921, he was the son of the late, Clinton Bates and Virginia Hutson Morris. He graduated from Greensboro High School in 1938, at which time he entered the United States Navy, in which he served until 1945. On September 14, 1941, he married Katherine Shockley. He began working for Kemper Insurance in 1954, and then spent ten years with the American Auto Association. Later, he was the general manager of Seward's Marina for fifteen years, and then worked as a car salesman at George Thompson's until 1974.

Mr. Morris was the oldest living member and past Exalted Ruler of the Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks, Lodge # 1622. He was also a founding member of the Caroline Memorial Post #7937 of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

He is survived by his children, Donna Minner and her husband, Jimmy, of Greensboro and John Morris, and his wife, Jennifer, of Greensboro; his grandchildren, Scotty Minner and Samantha Morris; and his great-grandson, Briar Colt Minner.

A funeral service will be held at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Easton on Friday, July 16 at 11:00 a.m., where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be held at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Easton.
