



Isabel Cook Lowery Ewing

June 25, 1924 - December 17, 2014

Isabel Cook Lowery Ewing died on December 17, 2014, at Anne Arundel Medical Center surrounded by her loving family. She was 90 years old.

Born in Stevensville, MD, she was the daughter of the late Claude and Reba Roe Lowery. She grew up on Kent Island and was a graduate of Stevensville High School Class of 1941. She attended Washington College and then married John Nacrelli of Chester, PA, in 1943. When he predeceased her in 1945, she moved back to Kent Island to work as a school teacher in Grasonville. On January 1, 1947 she married James Ewing, and they resided in Grasonville, Chester, and later Marling Farm. Isabel would co-operate the Circle Restaurant with her husband for 27 years. They would winter in Fort Lauderdale, FL, until 2007 when they stayed in Maryland year round.

Mrs. Isabel's greatest ambition was to be a loving wife and mother, which she fully accomplished. She was a member of Christ Church and the VFW Ladies Auxiliary. She enjoyed knitting, doing needlework; RVing, cheering on the Baltimore Colts, vacationing in Ocean City, and cooking.

She is survived by her husband, James "Jimmy" Ewing; three daughters, Dian Rowe (Donald), Claudia Jewell (Charles), and Beth Coppage (Alan); one son, James Ewing, Jr. (Bobbie Kaye); grandchildren, Lauren, Chuck, Gretchen, Nick, Tucker, Katie, Missy, Joann, Donnie, Jamie; and 12 great-grandchildren;

along with many nieces and nephews. In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her brother, John Claude Lowery.

A visitation will be held on Sunday, December 21, 2014, at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, 106 Shamrock Road, Chester, MD, from 2-4 p.m. and 6-8 p.m. A funeral service will be held on Monday, December 22, 2014, at Christ Church in Stevensville, MD at 2 p.m. Interment will follow at Stevensville Cemetery.

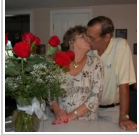
