



## Isabel G. Leaf

May 12, 1930 - March 15, 2014

Isabel Grabowski Leaf of Chestertown, MD, formerly of Chester, MD, died on March 15, 2014, at Heron Point in Chestertown. She was 83.

Isabel was born in Baltimore, MD, the daughter of the late Peter and Josephine Marie Grabowski. She was educated at Notre Dame Prep School in Baltimore and graduated from the University of Maryland with a Bachelor's of Science degree majoring in Bacteriology. She worked at the University of Maryland and Johns Hopkins University as a research scientist in Virology. Next, she worked as a writer in creating the science portion of the Maryland State Employment Assessment Testing. Mrs. Leaf then worked for many years as the Chief of Personnel for the Maryland District court system. She was employed by the State of Maryland for 27 years.

In 1953, she married Robert H. Leaf who later predeceased her on August 2, 2005. Both were first generation Americans. They built two homes together and spent their retirement years crabbing, fishing, and gardening. An extensive traveler, she traveled to three continents and numerous countries.

She is survived by her children, Karen Becker of Brick, NJ, Robert Leaf of Cambridge, MD, and Linda Bytnar of Raphine, VA; and grandchildren, Brian, Kate, and Lauren.

Services will be held at Wesley Hall at Heron Point on Friday, March 21, at 11 a.m. Interment will be held in Stevensville Cemetery.
