Isabelle Dorothy Chubet, known affectionately as "Skip," passed away on July 22, 2024, at the age of 94 in Easton, Maryland. Born on July 3, 1930, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, to Irish immigrant parents John Logan and Teresa Grant, she embraced a life marked by devotion to her family, faith, and community.

Skip, a devout Catholic, was an active member of Saints Peter & Paul Catholic Church, where she contributed to the community through her involvement in the choir and various church activities. She pursued her higher education at Penn State University, majoring in Elementary Education, and dedicated her life to being a devoted homemaker and loving mother.

Her life was marked by a passion for a variety of hobbies including golf, where she won numerous awards in the ladies league in Lancaster, PA, cross-stitch needlepoint, bowling, bridge and gardening. Her love for sports including Penn State and Notre Dame teams as well as men's and women's golf tournaments was well-known. Skip had a passion for cooking, famously known for her crab dip and 'Grammy' potatoes. She had a keen interest in travel, loved cats which she always named with Irish monikers, was an avid reader and enjoyed crossword puzzles, PBS programming and musical

theatre.

Skip was predeceased by her beloved husband, Lawrence "Larry" Chubet, her son, Matthew L. Chubet, and six of her siblings. She leaves behind her daughters Teresa Chubet and Marcella (John) Jackson, her son Mark L. Chubet, grandchildren Jake Miller and Brad (Raven) Jackson, great-grandchildren Robin and Charles 'CJ' Jackson, her sister Cathy (Bill) Brown, and many nieces and nephews.
