J. Francis Larrimore of Chestertown, MD,. died on August 4, 2014, at Christiana Hospital following a long illness with his loving wife by his side. He was 70 years old.

Born in Chestertown, he was the son of the late James Medford Larrimore and Frances Bennett Larrimore. He was a life-long resident of Chestertown.

Francis worked for the Maryland State Highway Administration for 30 years in their Traffic Sign Division, retiring in 1996. "Fat Cat" enjoyed gardening and loved to crab and cook. He loved to play cards with his friends on Tuesday nights. He also enjoyed trap shooting, and his cooking was taken to the next level working with Charlie Copppage and his barbecue competitions, as well as his delicious crab soup that he enjoyed sharing with friends.

In addition to his parents, he is predeceased by a brother, James (Jimmy) Larrimore.

He is survived by his wife of 47 years, Diane Stant Larrimore; brother-in-law, David Stant and wife Brenda; his mother-in-law, Mildred Dallas; and many nieces, nephews, cousins, and extended family.
