J. Patrick McCurdy, III, of Chestertown, MD, died on Thursday, August 11, 2016 at University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Chestertown. He was 52.

Born on July 29, 1964, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of Joseph Patrick McCurdy, Jr. and Mary Bridget McCurdy, both of Chestertown. He was a graduate of Loyola Blakefield High School in 1983 and attended Loyola College, graduating in 1987. He later attended University of Baltimore Law School. Patrick worked for a Disability Resource Group in Baltimore, then worked for Disability Advocacy group in Washington, DC. He eventually went to work for the State of Maryland, as a Counselor for Vocational Rehabilitation. Patrick was on the board for Baltimore Neighborhoods and the board for Maryland Disability Law Center.

He enjoyed coin collecting, art collecting, and loved history. He loved to talk to people about politics and was a family historian. Patrick enjoyed Baltimore Ravens football and was a season ticket holder.

In addition to his parents, he is survived by his sisters, Bridget McCurdy Kotelly, Bissett McCurdy Schwanke and Megan McCurdy Spry; four nieces; Maeve, Genevieve, Celia and Fiona; and his loving cat Bess.

A memorial service will be held at a later date to be announced.
