sustained me.

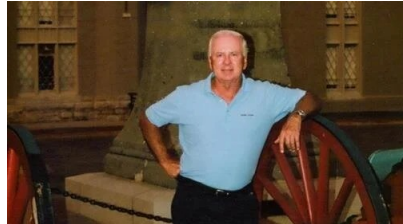
As I depart this earthly realm I just have one question: “can I have a mulligan?”.
