



Jack Meredith Burch

July 19, 1932 - April 28, 2012

Jack Meredith Burch, 79, of Easton, MD, and formerly of Annapolis, MD, died on Saturday, April 28, 2012, at his home surrounded by his family. Born in Baltimore on July 19, 1932, he was the son of the late Charles Joseph Burch, Sr., and Elva Eugene Roberts Burch.

Mr. Burch graduated from Glen Burnie High School in 1950. He served in the United States Navy as an electrician from 1952 – 1954. He was employed with AT & T for 35 years, retiring as an Operations Supervisor. Mr. Burch and his wife Barbara moved to Easton in 1991.
