John “Jack” Haslup Jacquette of Rock Hall, Maryland died on April 15, 2001 at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Chestertown, Md. He was 88.

Born in Rock Hall, Maryland on April 5, 1913, he was the son of the late James LeRoy and Irene Rena Metcalf Jacquette.

Mr. Jacquette was a graduate of Rock Hall High School. In 1937 he married Ethel Louise Reihl they lived in Rock Hall, Md. In 1947 he opened and operated a service station appropriately named “Jacks Service Station”. He owned and ran the service station until his retirement in 1986.

Mr. Jacquette enjoyed working on old cars, especially an “oldie” of 1917, which was used many times in the Rock Hall Fireman’s Parade. He also enjoyed cooking and gardening; he shared his bounties with so many. Mr. Jacquette enjoyed playing Santa Clause to his nieces and nephews. He was a friend to all.

In addition to his wife of 64 years, he is survived by a daughter: Mara Ellen Jacquette of Rock Hall, Md.; three brothers Richard Jacquette, Randolph Jacquette and his wife of Bertha, and Curtis and his wife Pat all of Rock Hall, Md. Several nieces and nephews also survive him.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday April 19, 2001 at 1:00 P.M. at Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church in Rock Hall, Md.
