



## Jack MacKnight

September 11, 1934 - April 2, 2010

John “Jack” Walter MacKnight died peacefully at his home of heart failure with loved ones at his side on April 2, 2010. He was 75 years old.

Born in Darby, PA on September 11, 1934, he was the son of William and Ruth Payne MacKnight. He earned a Bachelor of Chemical Engineering Degree from the University of Virginia in 1957, and a Master’s of Business Administration in 1962 from Stanford University. He served as a LTJG from June 1957 to September 1960 in the United States Naval Reserve. He spent the majority of his career working as an executive for IBM.

Mr. MacKnight was a member of the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship in Easton. He was a guide at the Monterey Bay Aquarium, and a member and past treasurer of the St. Michaels Rotary.

He is survived by his wife, Lynne MacKnight of Wittman, whom he married on December 5, 1964; his children, Christopher MacKnight (Melinda) of Pleasanton, CA, Christian MacKnight (Elisabeth) of San Francisco, CA, and Joanna Blakeman (Brad); his siblings, Barbara Freeston (Bert), Robert Williams, and Carol Mainey (David); his grandchildren, Macie Blakeman and C.J. MacKnight; and his first wife, Johnsie Moffett. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a grandson, Kyle Blakeman.

A funeral service will be held at Unitarian Universalist Fellowship in Easton on Thursday, April 8 at 2:00 pm, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

A private interment will be held at a later date.
