Jack Andrews Dutrow of Queenstown, MD died at his home Thursday, October 24, 2002. He was 54.

Born June 25, 1948, he was the son of Mildred Andrews Dutrow and the late Gordon Dutrow. He was a 1966 graduate of Severna Park High School and after high school he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and served during the Vietnam War from 1966 to 1970 as a jet mechanic. Mr. Dutrow returned to Arnold, MD and married Kaye Irwing on December 18, 1971. He began a career as a self-employed concrete contractor. They resided in Arnold, MD until 1977 when they moved to Chester, MD. Mr. Dutrow worked for Queen Anne's County Roads as an engineer 1986-1993 and later returned to concrete contracting. In 1992 they moved to Queenstown, MD. Mr. Dutrow enjoyed fishing, boating and Eastern Shore living.

In addition to his wife and mother, Mr. Dutrow is survived by a daughter, Sherry D. Butera of Stevensville; a sister, Terry Wallawski of Baltimore; a niece, Tina Wallawski and a nephew, Michael Wallawski, both of Baltimore.
