Jacob Earl Stump, Jr. of Kennedyville, MD, died on September 25, 2004, at his residence. He was 81.

Born in Elkhart, Indiana on February 22, 1923, he was the son of the late Jacob Earl Stump Sr. and Reva McDorman Stump. Dr. Stump graduated Libby High School in 1941 in Toledo, Ohio. He received a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Toledo in 1943 and a Doctor of Medicine degree in 1947 from the University of Cincinnati.

Dr. Stump served in the U.S. Army from 1943-1946 and as a physician in the U.S. Public Health Service from 1951-1954.

He operated a private medical practice from 1954 to 1967 in New York City, and operated a private practice in Tenafly, NJ, from 1967 until 1996, when he retired.

On September 24, 1949, he married Margaret Watkins in Lima, Ohio. He graduated from the New York Psychoanalytic Institute in 1957; was a Life Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association, President of the New Jersey Psychoanalytic Society from 1978-1980. Dr. Stump was also medical director of Mid-Bergen Community Mental Health Center in Paramus, NJ, from 1977 until 1996.

He enjoyed golf, skiing, and tennis and was an avid sailor and bridge player. He was a member of Chester River Yacht and Country Club.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a daughter, Susan Storm of Wilmington, DE; two sons, David Stump of Millville, NJ, and Daniel Stump of Cary, NC; one sister, Dora Herold of Toledo, Ohio, and four grandchildren.

A Memorial service will be held on Saturday, October 2, 2004, at 11:00 a.m. at Shrewsbury Church, 12395 Vansant Corner Rd., Kennedyville, MD.

Interment will be private.
