



Jacqueline G. Henson

December 14, 1923 - February 15, 2012

Born in Nesquehoning, PA, on December 14, 1923, Mrs. Henson was the youngest of 11 children of George Greco and Jacqueline Vaiana Greco.

Graduated from St. Joseph's College in Emmitsburg, MD, in 1944. She received a Masters in Biology from George Washington University in Washington, DC.

Mrs. Henson began her career as a Biologist at the National Institutes of Health in 1945. There she met Edwin R. Henson, Jr., whom she married on September 6, 1952. They made their first home on Johnson Avenue in Bethesda, MD, where they welcomed their four children. They lived for 35 years on Wadsworth Drive in Bethesda before moving to Queenstown, MD, to live with their eldest daughter, Jacqueline A. Henson.

Mrs. Henson loved her kids and grandkids more than anything, made the world's greatest meatballs, and loved the Redskins in spite of everything.

A devout Catholic, Mrs. Henson was a member of St. Jane De Chantal parish in Bethesda for more than 50 years and a parishioner of Our Mother of Sorrows for ten years. She valued education highly and was very proud of her children's many accomplishments. Her interest in her grandchildren's future and the love of her family helped to sustain through a lengthy illness. The

family is comforted by the belief that she is reunited with her beloved sister, Toni, and her dear friend, Virginia.

Mrs. Henson died in Easton Memorial Hospital on February 15, 2012. She is survived by Edwin R. Henson, Jr., her husband of nearly 60 years; their children (Jacqueline A. Henson, Karen Henson and her husband Michael Falba, Mary Beth Henson and her partner Danielle Henripin, and Edwin R. Henson, III, and his wife Lorinda); grandchildren (Nicholas and Michael Falba, and Kaitlyn and Christopher Henson); and many dear nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Services will be held Monday at 11a.m. at St. Peter's in Queenstown, MD.
