Jacqueline “Jackie” W. Horney, 85, passed away on January 1, 2021. She was born on April 15, 1935 in Chester, MD, the daughter of the late Edgar and Agnes O’Donnell Wyatt.

Jackie was a gifted writer, artist, and award-winning photographer.
