Jacqueline Ann Snyder of Wittman, MD died on Wednesday, March 9, 2005 at the Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD. She was 77.

Born in Washington, DC on May 26, 1927, she was the daughter of the late Anna Berezoski Knox and Ferdinand B. Haddaway.

After attending Nativity and Sacred Heart Parochial Schools in Washington, DC, she moved to Tilghman, MD in 1941. She attended St. Michaels High School, graduating in 1945. She then returned to Washington, DC and was employed by the Internal Revenue Service. After leaving Internal Revenue in 1953 she was employed as a secretary with the United Association of Plumbers and Steamfitters International of the United States and Canada. Upon retirement on June 1, 1989 she moved to Wittman, MD.

She was a member of the VFW Ladies Auxiliary, Post #5118, American Legion Ladies Auxiliary Post #70 of Easton and the Bag Ladies Local #102, St. Michaels, MD.

Mrs. Snyder is survived by a son, William Wayne Sinclair and his wife, Kay; grandchildren, Bill, Stacey and Kevin and his wife, Stephenie and a sister, Victoria Daisy of Tilghman. She was pre-deceased by a son, Michael B. Snyder, who died in 1984; a sister, Jerry Breneman, who died in 2003 and a

brother, Nicholas Haddaway, who died in 1983.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, March 17, 2005 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Easton, MD where friends may call on Wednesday evening from 6 – 8 PM.

Burial will be in Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton, MD.
