



## Jacqueline Coulby Smith

Jacqueline Coulby Smith, of Easton, died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton on Saturday, October 30, 2004. She was 69.

Born in Easton, March 27, 1935, she was the daughter of Mary Putman Coulby of Easton and the late Robert Kenneth Coulby. After graduating from Easton High School in 1953, she attended the School of Nursing at Memorial Hospital, Easton, and later earned her Licensed Practical Nurse certification. After moving to Dundalk in 1956, she worked for thirteen years as an office nurse. In 1969, she and her husband moved to Severna Park where she was very active as a volunteer with the Rape Crisis Center in Annapolis. In 1983, they moved to Easton where she worked for several years as a geriatric nurse at the Meridian Nursing Home-The Pines and later at Marvel Hall, Wm Hill Manor, both in Easton. She retired in 1991 for health reasons.

A member of Christ Church in Easton, she was devoted to her family and enjoyed buying and selling costume jewelry and flower gardening.

Surviving, in addition to her mother, are her husband N. Steffens Smith, whom she married Dec. 18, 1954; two daughters, Steffeny Coulby Tremain and her husband, Al. of Los Altos, CA and Mary Lindsay Riehl and her husband, Pickett of Freeland, MD ; a son, Jeffrey Grant Smith and his wife, Lynn of Easton and five grandchildren, C. Pickett Riehl, III, Coulby Elizabeth Riehl,

Katherine Moran Riehl, Amy Coulby Wilson and Charles L. Cox. Another son, Robert Steffens Smith, died in 1955.

Funeral services will be held at Christ Church, Easton, on Tuesday, November 2nd, at 11 A.M.

Private burial will be at Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD.
